



Legendary All-Star Game Inaugurates Bradford High's New TigerTurf

Big 30 Don Raabe Charities Classic held on TigerTurf, chosen for its quality, value, warranty. The new system was recently installed by Ohio-based Sports Construction Group.

Completed on July 28, the field hosted the Big 30 Don Raabe Charities Classic All-Star Game August 2. Pennsylvania dominated New York 27-0 in the 35th annual contest, which showcased graduated high school seniors from 15 Pennsylvania schools and 16 in New York.

Since then the system has been widely used to support a myriad of sports and activities at Bradford High, including football, soccer and band, noted Walter.
