



Flights to Iceland Resume from Baltimore / Washington DC

Icelandair is returning to Baltimore / Washington International Airport after a short winter break.

London, United Kingdom, April 12, 2007 --(PR.com)-- Icelandair has resumed [direct flights between Baltimore / Washington](#) and Keflavik International Airport in time for the busy summer season. There will be daily flights to and from the Icelandic and US capitals as of April.
