"My fantasy was to be in the music business. Play music. Be one of the guys in the Rolling Stones or something. Be cool." Dale, Jr. said.

Dale, Jr. was also asked, "What do you enjoy doin' that people don't know about you?"

Jr. couldn't think of anything then later said, "I think the answer to your question, sir, is that I can, I'm real proud of the fact that I can build a computer. So I've always been a big computer geek. I'm a real big computer geek. So that would surprise a lot of people that I spent a lot a time learning how to build a computer."
