



On-line Database Offers Free Platform for RFP Exchange; Registers Its 15,000th User and 1,500 New Users Each Month

The site now hosts an average of 250 active projects at any one time. Companies, non-profits and municipalities come to the site to download sample RFPs so they can write their own, then upload the completed RFP to the website to gain competitive bids. A number of educators also use the site as an example of a place where projects can be found, teaching students how to write RFPs and respond to them.
