What Size Is The Right Size?

Use the following guideline to select the right dog house:

Roof Height should be 25% to 50% taller than the dog. Door height should be $\frac{3}{4}$ the shoulder height of the dog. The overall inside dimensions should not be more than 25% longer than the dog in either direction. If the dog will be outside all year round it is best to use an insulated dog house. Customers can purchase warming mats to help fight the cold. It is essential to insure that the water supply is clean and that it does not freeze. There are many watering devices available to insure a continuous clean water supply. One will also need a non-freeze water container. These stainless steel water containers assure a fresh water supply even in the coldest weather. Hot weather should also be a concern and there are



cooling mats available that customer should consider.
