- (3) Expected results during funding period and evaluating measures of success

To be eligible for a DoJiggy Giving grant, an organization must have 501(c)3 or equivalent non-profit status. All schools & educational institutions are also eligible and are exempt from this requirement. Recipient organizations must also have a budget of less than \$1 million USD. Grants are not limited to US-based companies. International organizations are encouraged to submit an application along with international non-profit documentation in place of the 501(c)3 IRS letter.

To be considered for this year's awards, organizations must submit an online application on or before November 30, 2010 at 11:59 pm (MST).
