

PR Manual Filled with Specific and Detailed "How To" Tips & Tricks

This makes the Manual especially attractive for smaller companies where an individual wears a number of hats simultaneously (in larger companies, top management may find out from the Manual what they should be getting – but aren't – from their PR departments).

According to Pete Budzilovich: "Perhaps the biggest value of our Manual is that not only it says what a dynamic PR operation should be doing to achieve its goals, but also How and Why, and in great detail. Thus, the Manual contains 15 illustrations – samples of releases, article outlines, editor invitations, memos, flow charts. Speaking about values, I would venture a guess that if the reader finds just one useful idea in it, it will more than pay for the Manual."
